News was received yesterday morning in Rushworth of the death of Mr. Alex. Dowling, which occurred in the Mooroopna Hospital on Wednesday night.

The deceased had been in ill-health for some months past. A few days ago he was taken to the Mooroopna Hospital where he passed away as stated.

The late Mr. Dowling was 73 years of age and was born in Heathcote. He came to Rushworth 39 years ago, where he was engaged in mining and forest work. He was unmarried.

He was a well-known figure in the life of the town, and was of a quiet and unassuming disposition and had many friends.

He leaves two stepbrothers (Robert and George Hall, Rushworth) and a sister-in-law (Nurse McLeod, Rushworth).

The funeral takes place today, to the Rushworth cemetery.
