Pneumonic influenza claimed another Rushworth victim on Saturday last, when Mr Alfred Sayers, of Stanhope Road, succumbed to an attack of that dreaded complaint.

Death ensued during the early hours of Saturday morning at the Mooroopna Hospital, to which institution the poor fellow had only been taken on the previous day.

Deceased was the eldest son of the late Mr and Mrs Wm. Sayers and was 50 years of age. He was a quiet, unassuming person and general regret was expressed on his demise. He leaves a widow and two daughters.

The remains were interred in the local cemetery on Sunday afternoon, the funeral obsequies being performed by Mr J. Jones (Presbyterian). Mr E. Anderson had charge of the mortuary arrangements.
