Mr Archibald McNicol, a well-known and respected resident of Rushworth, passed away at the Mooroopna Hospital on Tuesday last, at the age of 63 years, having been an inmate of the hospital for the last eight weeks.

The deceased came to Rushworth in the early mining days and engaged in mining for some time.

He left Rushworth a few years ago and went to Rutherglen, where he was engaged as underground manager in the Prentice and other mines.

He returned to Rushworth about 8 years ago and has been residing here ever since.

The late Mr. McNicol was a widower, his wife having predeceased him many years ago. He leaves one son and two brothers, Messrs Hugh and Jack McNicol of Costerfield.

The remains were brought from Mooroopna on Tuesday yesterday and interred in the Rushworth Cemetery, the Rev. Gordon Nelson officiating at the graveside.

A number of townspeople followed the remains to the cemetery.
