A sad death occurred at Rushworth on Monday morning last, when Mr Arthur Kittle, a visitor of Messrs Siggs and Arthur's, passed away.

Deceased was a resident of Bellingen, N.S.W., and followed farming pursuits. About ten days

ago he came to Rushworth for a holiday and to see his old friends, Mr Siggs and Mrs Arthur. Shortly after his arrival, however, he became ill, and his medical adviser contended that he was suffering from heat apoplexy. He gradually got worse and other complications ensued, terminating in his death as stated.

He was about 64 years of age, and at one time, about ten years ago, resided at Shepparton, where he carried on business as a builder and contractor.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. F. J. Jennings officiating at the grave.
