Typhoid fever is still on the [word left out] in Rushworth. Out of the 10 or 12 cases that have already been reported only one death has occurred, the victim to the epidemic being the youngest daughter of Mr John Groom, of Chinaman's Flat.

Much sympathy is felt for the family.

The remains were interred in the local cemetery yesterday.

Rushworth cemetery listings include a C. Groom, no Groome. It would be hoped that the family notice had the correct spelling.
