We regret to record the death of Mr Charles Thomas Berry, a lifelong resident of this district, who died at Mooroopna Hospital on Saturday last after a painful illness.

Born at Whroo 46 years ago, he was the eldest son of Mrs and the late Mr Alfred Berry, of Rushworth. He spent practically the whole of his life in this district and was a popular and respected citizen.

He had suffered intermittently for a number of years with the complaint that ultimately caused his demise.

Twenty years ago the late Mr Berry married Miss Bessie Lonsdale of Toolleen. She predeceased him about six years ago. He leaves two daughters, Doris and Phyllis to mourn the loss of a devoted father. Four sisters and a brother also survive him, viz Esther (Mrs Lonsdale, Ganmain, N.S.W.), Lucy (Mrs A. Willyan), George (Melbourne), Martha (Mrs J. Perry) and Emily (Mrs J. Harley).

The remains were interred at the Rushworth cemetery on Sunday, Mr A. F. Landers officiating at the graveside. The funeral cortege was large and representative.
