## Child of Mr and Mrs F. Corner

## **Rushworth Chronicle**

25 January, 1918

An infant two months old (the surviving child of twins), son of Mr and Mrs F. Corner, of Moora road, Rushworth, was found dead in bed on Saturday morning last.

A magisterial inquiry was conducted by Mr E. A. Muhlhan, J.P., and evidence was tendered by the parents of the child to the effect that it had been put to bed in apparently good health, and seemed alright when it awakened about 4 o'clock in the morning. Two hours later the father thought the child looked very pale, and on making a closer inspection was horrified to find it dead.

Dr Heily, who had made a post mortem examination of the body, deposed that the child had died from accidental suffocation during sleep, and a verdict was given to that effect. The remains were interred in the local cemetery on Sunday.
