Deep regret was expressed in the town when it became known that Dr. A. J. Triado had passed away at his residence, Moora street.

He had not been in very good health during the past two or three weeks and went to Melbourne to consult a specialist. He returned home and had to take to his bed. Alarming symptoms set in and he gradually sank and died as stated.
