DEATH.

MACFARLANE.—At Clyde Cottage, Rushworth, on 8th inst., Duncan Sinclair Macfarlane. Aged 31 years. Very deeply regretted.

It is with extreme regret that we record the death of Mr Duncan Macfarlane, a highly respected employee of Messrs J. G. Helyar and Co., which occurred at his residence, Rushworth, on Saturday morning last.

Mr Macfarlane had only been ailing a few weeks, having caught a severe cold, which developed into congestion of the lungs. Brain fever supervened, and he expired as stated, at the early age of 31 years.

Deceased leaves a young wife and two children to mourn their loss.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Sunday, the impressive service of the Foresters' order being rendered at the grave.
