

Elizabeth McQuaid

A magisterial inquiry was held on Tuesday last, at Ryan's Imperial hotel, Rushworth, before H. G. Brice, Esq., J.P., touching the death of Elizabeth McQuaid, who expired at the Waranga Basin on Monday last.

Evidence was tendered by Dr Heily to the effect that he had made a post mortem examination of the remains and found that death was due to fatty degeneration of the heart.

Deceased was aged about 35 years and had been resident at the Basin for about two years past.

She had at one time been in the Mooroopna hospital and had not been well for some time. On Monday last Dr Heily was sent for but on arrival he found the woman dead.
