A very sad fatality occurred to a young man, 24 years of age, named Frank Miller, who was employed at the Spring Greek Gold Mining Company's ground, Graytown.

It appears that on Tuesday last, whilst working in the mine, some loose earth fell on him, which caused his death.

The deceased was in the prime of life, and much sympathy is felt for the parents, who reside on the Murchison road, Rushworth.

A magisterial inquiry was held yesterday, when a verdict of accidental death was returned.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth Cemetery during the afternoon.
