

## **Frank Murdoch**

**27 December, 1895**

A large number of people gave expression to their sympathy with Mr and Mrs Murdoch in the sad loss of their second youngest son, Frank, by attending the funeral, which took place on Friday afternoon last.

The remains were first conveyed to the Church of England, where service was held, and the procession then wended its way to the local cemetery, being joined "en route" by the boys attending the State school, Mr Blaikie having them all drawn up in line ready to fall in as the

funeral passed the school.

The service at the grave, as also at the church, was conducted by the Rev. J. R. Walker. The coffin was covered with many nice wreaths by friends.
