An old man named Fred Fuhlton, a resident of the Wanalta Village Settlement, died at the Mooroopna Hospital on Saturday last from an attack of inflammation of the bowels.

Fuhlton, who was 70 years of age, made a will in which he left several small bequests to personal friends, the balance of his property to be equally divided between the Rushworth Benevolent Society and the Mooroopna Hospital. The estate is said to be worth £200.

His remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Sunday, the Rev. J. R. Walker officiating at the grave.
