Pneumonic influenza claimed another Rushworth victim on Monday evening last, when Mr Fred. Berry, of Stanhope Road, crossed that bourn from which no traveller returneth.

Deceased was seen about the town as late as Friday last, although he then complained of feeling unwell. He was a son of Mr Alfred Berry, of Whroo, and a member of the firm of Berry Bros., sawmillers, Moora.

He was only 34 years of age, and was a man who carried the goodwill and respect of all with whom he became associated by reason of his upright and jovial nature.

The circumstances surrounding the death of Mr Berry are particularly sad from the fact that he leaves a young wife and six small children, the youngest but a fortnight old.

The funeral took place on Wednesday afternoon and was attended by a large number of mourners.

The Rev. Rowell conducted the funeral service while Mr E. Anderson had charge of the mortuary arrangements.
