DEATH.

SMITH—On the 8th inst, at Rushworth, Frederick Heathorn Smith, chemist, aged 36 years.

On the 8th inst. Mr Frederick Smith, who has for a long time carried on the business of a chemist at Rushworth, expired at his residence, High street.

The deceased was 34 years of age, and during his lifetime was identified with everything of an intellectual nature which was promoted in the township, and his influence in that direction is testified to by the capital collection in the Rushworth Mechanics' [Institute], and the varied and interesting works which form its circulating library.

Altogether, Mr Smith was a man whose converse added much to ordinary intelligence, and whose bearing discovered the qualities of a genuine friendship and a fairness of purpose.

The remains of the deceased gentleman were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Wednesday last.
