

## **Geo. (George) Davis**

**Rushworth Chronicle**

An old mining identity of the district passed away on Sunday last in the person of Mr Geo. Davis, the cause of his death being miner's complaint.

For many years deceased resided at Whroo, where he pursued his occupation as a miner with varying results. About two years ago, however, he removed to Rushworth with his wife and family, but almost ever since he has suffered very severely from his complaint.

He was a shoemaker by trade, and in his later days also did a little in this direction.

He was of a very kind disposition and was highly respected.

His remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Tuesday afternoon when a number of sympathisers followed to the grave.

Deceased was a member of the Whroo branch of the Foresters' Lodge and a number of the brethren of this lodge, together with some from the Rushworth branch, attended the funeral.

The Rev. J. R. Walker performed the funeral obsequies. Bro. T. G. Anderson read the lodge service.
