With the death Mr. Mr George Anderson, farmer, of "Waranga View," Waranga, which occurred on Thursday evening, 7th inst., there passed from our midst another old and highly respected resident of the district.

Deceased suffered from an internal complaint, and his death was not unexpected, as, although he had received expert medical attention some time ago, no hope was held out for his recovery.

Deceased was a son of the late Mr Thomas Anderson, farmer, of Kyabram, and was a native of March, Cambridgeshire, England. About 25 years ago he selected land at Waranga and resided there ever since.

He leaves a wife and grown-up family of eleven sons and daughters to mourn his death, and to them sympathy is extended.

Deceased, who was 62 years of age, was a quiet, hard-working, unassuming person, and the respect in which he was held was shown on Saturday afternoon last, when a large number of people followed his remains to their last resting-place, the Rushworth cemetery.

The Rev. Rowell officiated at the grave, while the funeral arrangements were in the hands of Mr E. Anderson.
