OBITUARY.

A sad death occurred at the Mooroopna Hospital on Tuesday evening last when Mr Harold Enders, of Carag, succumbed to an attack of appendicitis, after an ill ness of a little more than a week's duration.

Deceased, who was the eldest son of Mr Frank Enders, of Carag, was but 28 years of age, and regret was general when word came to hand on Wednesday morning that he had passed away on the previous evening.

About a week ago Dr Utber was called to attend de ceased and he at once recognised the case as one of a very serious nature, and the same afternoon hastened his departure to the hospital named. There he was submitted to operation, but the case had gone too far and blood poisoning supervened, deceased gradually sinking and passing away as stated.

The blow is a severe one to the family, for whom the fullest sympathy is felt.

The remains were conveyed to Rushworth by train yesterday and interred in the local cemetery, a large number of people joining the funeral cortege.

The Rev. Ingram officiated at the grave.
