It is with regret that we have this week to record the death of Henry John Richardson, a brother of Mr George Richardson, contractor, well known and much respected in the Rushworth and Heathcote districts for the past thirty years or so.

Deceased, who leaves a widow and one child to mourn their loss, went to his brother's contract, at Kettle's bridge, on Sunday last, and during the early hours of the following Monday morning was seized, at the camp, with a violent fit of coughing, which terminated in the breaking of a blood-vessel, the sufferer almost immediately expiring.

A numerous cortege followed the remains of the deceased to their last resting place in the Rushworth cemetery.
