DEATH.

KEOGH.—On the 18th inst., at Rushworth, Isabella, daughter of Patrick and Catherine Keogh, aged 17 years.

We regret to have to record the death of Miss Bella Keogh, daughter of Mr Patrick Keogh, of this town, which took place at his residence, Rushworth, yesterday.

Some ten weeks ago deceased contracted typhoid fever, and at various times during her lengthened and painful illness was reported to be in a dying state, but, thanks to good nursing and proper medical attention, she always rallied.

But recently she was reported out of danger, so that the blow will fall doubly hard upon the bereaved family.

Deceased, whose remains will be interred in the local cemetery, on Sunday afternoon, at 3 o'clock, was 17 years of age, and a great favourite with all who knew her.
