

## Jacob Geisler

GEISLER. -- On 29th November, at the Mooroopna Hospital, Jacob Geisler, aged 67 years, second eldest son of the late Frederick and Julia Ann and beloved brother of George, Conrad, Mary (Mrs. Haub), Catherine (Mrs. Popple) and Margaret (Mrs. Brideson). Rest in peace.

Another of the old pioneers of Rushworth passed away on Saturday last 29th ult., in the person of Mr. Jacob Geisler, whose death took place in the Mooroopna Hospital, of which he had been an inmate for only a few days, the cause of death being miners' complaint.

The deceased who was 65 years of age, was born in South Australia and came to Australia with his parents quite a lad. He engaged in mining until about 14 years ago, and since then has resided with his sister and brother-in-law (Mr. and Mrs. R. Brideson), being unmarried.

He was the second eldest son of the late Mr. and Mrs. F. Geisler, and brother of Messrs George and Conrad Geisler, of Rushworth and Mrs. Haub, Mrs. Popple and Mrs. R. Brideson.

The late Mr Geisler was of a quiet and unassuming nature and was highly respected by all who knew him.

The funeral took place on Sunday, the remains being interred in the Rushworth Cemetery. The Rev. Boyd (Presbyterian) officiated at the grave.
