

James Stanley Stewart

Our readers will learn with very great regret of the sad bereavement which Mr and Mrs Duncan Stewart, of Carag Carag, have suffered in the death of their son, James Stanley, the sad event taking place at Rochester on Wednesday evening, the 12th inst.

Deceased was only 15 years of age, and his death came about rather unexpectedly. It appears that on the previous Sunday he became unwell and complained of a bad throat. As he was no better on the Monday he was taken to Rochester for medical examination, when the doctor pronounced him to be suffering from double quinsy and advised that he remain at a private hospital in the town for a few days.

On the Wednesday afternoon, however, he suddenly took worse and passed away as stated.

Much sympathy is felt for Mr and Mrs Stewart, who have had a large share of misfortune during the last couple of years.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Friday afternoon, the funeral cortege being a lengthy one. Mr Raff conducted the funeral service.
