He came from California with Captain Darby when it was first reported that gold had been discovered in Victoria and he found his way to Rushworth in 1854, and has remained here ever since.

He expired at Mr J. S. Darby's residence yesterday morning.

Rushworth cemetery's interment list contains only one Brooks, James, buried in a grave with a low number.
