A well-known mining identity, particularly so as regards the Costerfield district, passed away at Rushworth on Sunday last in the person of Mr Jas. Byrne.

Deceased, who suffered from consumption, had been unable to follow his usual employment for some years, and his death was not unexpected. He was 47 years of age, and the respect in which he was held was apparent from the large number who followed his remains to the grave on Monday afternoon.
