

Mr Jeremiah McLaughlin

The death occurred on Saturday evening last week at the Rushworth Bush Nursing Hospital of Mr. Jeremiah John McLaughlin, after a short illness, due to an attack of pneumonia.

The deceased was 63 years of age and was born at Yendon. He resided for the past 19 years at Wanalta and was engaged in woodcutting, etc.

He was well-known and respected in Rushworth and the Wanalta and Gobarup districts, his quiet and unassuming manner gaining him many friends, his death being much regretted.

The late Mr. McLaughlin was unmarried. He leaves a sister, Sarah (Mrs. McConville, Victoria police, of Richmond) and two brothers John (Ballarat) and Hugh (Richmond).

The funeral took place on Sunday last, from St. Mary's R. C. Church (where the body was taken after death) the remains being interred in the Rushworth Cemetery, many residents of the town and district following the cortege.

The burial service was read by the Rev. Father Tehan.

The coffin bearers were Messrs. W. C. Lambden, G. Thompson, J. McEvoy and N. Jacobson.
