We have to report the death of a man named John Carson, a resident of Rushworth for some twenty-four years.

The deceased, who had been on a drinking bout, was found dead on the farm of his employer, Mr Taylor, of Moora on Wednesday morning.

Carson was formerly the landlord of the White Horse Hotel, California Gully, Sandhurst.

The usual magisterial inquiry was dispensed with in this case, as Dr. Heily, who had been attending the deceased, was able to certify to the cause of death.
