A sad death occurred at Rushworth on Monday last, when, after a brief illness, a young man named John Henry Smith, son of Mr and Mrs W. Smith, Murchison Road, Rushworth, died as the result of pneumonia.

The deceased was only 19 years of age.

The funeral took place on Tuesday, the remains being interred in the local cemetery. Rev. Falconer (Church of England) read the burial service, and the funeral arrangements being in the hands of Mr E. F. Anderson.
