An old campaigner, in the person of Mr John Hill, passed away at Rushworth on Friday last, after a brief period of illness. He was in the street on the previous Wednesday, but was then apparently very unwell, and those who saw him were surprised at the change in him.

Deceased was a very straight-forward, honest old fellow, and was generally respected. He took part in the Ashantee war, and was the possessor of several medals in connection therewith.

He took a great interest in the present war, and his regret was that he was too old to go.

Deceased was 73 years of age. His remains were interred in the local cemetery on Saturday afternoon in the presence of a good number of people.
