It is with sincere regret that we record the death of Mr J. Mullany, eldest son of Mr Luke Mullany, of the Criterion hotel, Rushworth.

The sad event occurred on Wednesday morning, after a brief illness. Some twelve days ago he took to his bed, suffering from cirrhosis of the liver and kidneys and gradually became worse up to the time of his death, the immediate cause of death being heart failure.

Deceased was only 27 years of age, and was of such a kind, obliging disposition that he at once gained the good will and respect of all with whom he became associated, therefore the regret at his early demise is widespread.

He was the elder of the two sons and much regret is felt for Mr and Mrs Mullany and family in their untimely bereavement.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth Cemetery yesterday afternoon, a large number of sympathisers joining the funeral procession and thereby according deceased the last tribute of respect.

The Rev. Father O'Connell performed the funeral obsequies, Mr Anderson having charge of the mortuary arrangements.
