The death occurred at Mooroopna Hospital on Sunday last of Mr. John Stewart of Moora, a life-long resident of the Rushworth district, at the age of 71 years.

He was the third son of the late James and Jane Stewart, and was born at Five Mile Creek. He remained all his life in this district.

Deceased, who was a bachelor, had been ill for about three weeks. As a young man he had a foot removed as a result of an accident.

He was one of a family of twelve and is survived by two brothers and two sisters, viz., William (Rushworth), James (Rushworth), Lillian (Mrs N. Weppner, Melbourne) and Nellie (Melbourne). One sister, (Mrs Margaret Lawrie) died last month.
