The many friends of Mr John Kane will regret to learn of his death, which occurred at the Rushworth Bush nursing hospital early on Saturday morning last, (15th inst.) after a short illness.

The late Mr. Kane, who was 65 years of age, was in his normal health until a few days previously, when he took ill and was taken to the Bush Nursing Hospital from his residence in Moora road. He appeared to rally after his admission, but took a heart turn and passed away as stated.

He was the third son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Kane, and was born in Rushworth where he lived all his life. He was of a kind and happy disposition and did many a good turn but never a bad one, and made many friends in the town and district.

He was unmarried and leaves one brother, Hugh (Dick), who is the last surviving member of the family.

The funeral took place on Sunday last, a very large number of the residents of the town and district following his remains to the grave in the Rushworth Cemetery.

The service at the graveside was conducted by Rev Father Tehan, the funeral arrangements being carried out by Mr. E. F. Anderson.
