Mr Joseph Pettifer's many friends will regret to learn that he expired at Kyabram on Tuesday, after a lingering illness. The deceased was a native of Whroo, and resided there till he grew up. He afterwards worked at his trade—that of a shoemaker—in Rushworth for some time, removing to Kyabram about 16 years since. He leaves a wife and six children to mourn their loss, and much sympathy is felt for them in their bereavement.

The remains were brought to Rushworth for interment yesterday. Mr Bishop, of Kyabram, had charge of the funeral arrangements, and the Rev. Mr Leek, M.A., of the same town, officiated at the grave.
