Dr Eadon was called in on Sunday last to examine a girl named Mary Hilman, aged about 14, residing with her brother-in-law, Mr J. Wing, on the Stanhope road, Rushworth.

The doctor found the girl suffering from typhoid, and the usual course was followed, but without avail, and the sufferer expired between two and three o'clock yesterday [Thursday] morning.

The remains will be interred in the Rushworth cemetery this afternoon.
