The death occurred at her daughter's (Mrs Travers') residence, Rushworth, on Sunday morning last, of an old identity of the district in the person of Mrs Loughridge.

Deceased, who had reached the ripe old age of 88 years, had apparently passed quietly away in her sleep, for on going to awaken her on Sunday morning, Mrs Travers found that she was dead.

She was the mother of Mr James Loughridge, Murchison, and Mrs Travers and Mrs W. Johnson, Rushworth, and was widely known and respected throughout the Heathoote district.

Deceased had resided in Rushworth for ten years past, and was a colonist of 60 years.

The remains were interred in the local cemetery on Sunday afternoon, the Rev. J. R. Walker conducting the funeral service.
