An inquest was held at Darby's Rushworth Hotel yesterday, on the body of an old resident named Michael Walshe, who expired suddenly on the previous day.

From the evidence given by the deceased's wife it appears that he had started to return to work at Messrs Darby cordial factory, but when a few yards away he called for assistance. She managed to get him back to the house, but he expired a few minutes afterwards.

The deceased, who was only 48 years of age, was much respected. A verdict of death from disease of the heart was returned.
