After a long illness, born with much fortitude Miss Harriet (Hettie) Bedwell, third daughter of Mr and Mrs H. P. Bedwell, Rushworth, passed away in the Mooroopna Hospital (where she had been an inmate for some time)on Saturday morning last, at the age of 18 years.

The deceased was of a bright and happy nature and was much esteemed by all knew her, and deep sympathy is felt for her sorrowing parents and family.

The remains were brought from Mooroopna and interred in the Rushworth Cemetery on Monday. The coffin was first taken to St Paul’s Church of England where a short service was conducted by the Rev. Gordon Nelson, who also read the burial service at the graveside.

The funeral was largely attended and there were many floral tributes.
