It is with regret that we record a further loss sustained by Mr Downing, of the Waranga railway station, by the death of his daughter Annie, which sad event took place on Monday morning last.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Tuesday afternoon, a large number of friends joining the funeral cortege.
