The death occurred at the Tatura Bush Nursing Hospital on Saturday of Mr. Arthur Price, a well-known and respected resident of Tatura.

The funeral took place on Sunday to the Rushworth cemetery, and was largely attended. The burial service was conducted by the Rev. H. W. Laity.
