Rushworth Chronicle 5 April, 1918

The second death took place at the Mooroopna Hospital on 25th March, when Mr C. H. Davis, gunsmith, of Rushworth, passed away.

He was 89 years of age at the time of his death, and certainly was a remarkable man. Up till a couple of years ago he was a prominent figure on the Rushworth rifle range and could hold his own with the best of them as a shot.

Deceased claimed to have been through the Maori war, and carried a wound on the top of his head as a memento of the fight.

He leaves a wife to mourn his death.
