Mr J. Steigenberger, a very old and much respected resident of the district, passed away on Sunday morning last.

Deceased was 82 years of age and came to Victoria in 1841, and was thus a colonist of over 60 years. He came to this district over 40 years ago and some years since, settled on land he had acquired at Waranga, on the Murchison road, at which place he resided up to the time of his death, which resulted from senile debility.

Deceased leaves a widow and a grown-up family of live children to mourn their loss.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Monday, a large number of friends following the remains to their last resting place.

The Rev. J. R. Walker officiated at the grave.
