The death of Mrs Euphemia Vaughan, which occurred at her residence, Shepparton, on Tuesday last, removes another member of one of the oldest families in the Rushworth district, for she was a sister of Mr Isaac Furphy, J.P., Rushworth, and Mrs Alex Stewart of Sandhills, who are now the only survivors of the family.

The late Mrs Vaughan, who passed away after a very short illness, was 80 years of age.

She was born at Kangaroo Grounds, near Eltham. In 1869 she married Mr John Vaughan, and they spent most of their married life in New Zealand.

Mr and Mrs Vaughan came to Shepparton 10 years ago.

The deceased leaves her husband (who is an invalid), one son and a daughter.

The funeral took place on Wednesday, the remains being brought from Shepparton and interred in the Rushworth Cemetery. The Rev. F. Haynes conducted the funeral service at the graveside.
