There passed away at the residence of her son-in-law (Mr R. C. Geyle), Rushworth, on Sunday last, 18th August after a painful illness, Mrs G. Martin, relict of the late Arthur Martin, at the age of 78 years.

Deceased was born at Middleton, County Cork, Ireland, on April 11th, 1840, and came to Australia with friends in 1855. In 1857 she was married at St. Francis' R.C. church, Melbourne, by Rev. Dr Barry, to the late Arthur Martin, son of Rev. Thomas Martin, vicar of Rudham, Norfolk, England.

There were eleven children of the marriage, three only of whom are now living, viz., Mrs R. G. Geyle, Mrs T. B. Tazewell, West Australia, and Mrs E. E. Bailey, Bailieston.

Deceased, after her arrival in Australia, spent most of her life at Whroo and Bailieston, where she was widely known and respected.

The funeral took place on Tuesday, the remains being interred in the Rushworth cemetery. Messrs G. Jones, C. Mason and F. Le Deux acted as pall-bearers.

The burial service was read by Rev. Father Tehan, and Mr E. Anderson had charge of the mortuary arrangements.
