A very sad death occurred at Moora Road, Rushworth, on Tuesday morning last, when Mrs Dixon, wife of Mr Geo. Dixon, passed away after an illness of a few days only.

Deceased had only recently given birth to a child, and septic poisoning supervening was the immediate cause of death.

Mrs Dixon was a daughter of the late Mr Joseph Davey, of Gobarup, and was highly respected.

She was quite a young woman, being but 31 years of age, and widespread regret is expressed at her early demise.

She leaves a husband and two young children to mourn her death.

The remains were interred in the local cemetery on Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. F. J. Jennings conducting the service, and there being a large attendance of mourners.
