It is with regret that we record the death of Mrs Hall, wife of Mr George Hall, of Old Lead, Rushworth, which sad event occurred on Tuesday morning last.

Deceased had been ill for some time, suffering with heart trouble, but subsequently gangrene set in in one of her legs and death must have been a happy release from her sufferings.

She was only a young woman, being but 39 years of age, and was of a very quiet disposition and well respected.

Her husband is left with four small children, the youngest but a baby, to mourn their great loss.

The remains were interred in the local cemetery on Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. Father Moran conducting the funeral service.
