Another one of the fine old pioneers of this district died on Saturday last, in the person of Mrs Stewart, relict of the late John Stewart of Carag Carag, who passed away at the long age of 93.

She was one of the most respected and beloved identities of the district. She was the personification of kindness and her amiable disposition won her a host of friends who regret the passing of a fine old lady.

The late Mrs. Stewart was born in Inverness, Scotland, and came to Australia when only eight years of age.

Two sons, Allan and John, predeceased her, and the remaining members of the family are Mary, Duncan (Melbourne), Hughie (Nanneela) and Alex. (Carag).

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Sunday, the burial service being conducted by Rev. H. W. Laity. Messrs Kittle Bros. had charge of the funeral arrangements.
