The death of Mrs. Mabel Florence Enders, widow of the late Franklyn Enders, at the home of her sister, Mrs. H. C. Buzza, "Cresco Park", Stanhope, removes from this district one who, during her long residence here, had made many friends by her kindly and generous nature.

Mrs. Enders had experienced a long illness, which was borne with great patience and fortitude, and the end, which came on Thursday last, was not unexpected.

The late Mrs. Enders was born at Kyneton, where she received her education and lived for some years. In 1916 she was married to Mr. F. Enders and came to live at "Rosemont", Stanhope. Ever since then deceased has resided in the Stanhope district where her husband had farming interests.

During her lifetime Mrs. Enders had been an ardent worker for the Stanhope Church of England and also took a great interest in the welfare of Carag Carag State School.

She leaves one daughter, Jean, to mourn the loss of a devoted mother, one sister (Mrs. H. C. Buzza) and two brothers (Mr. W. H. Morton, Elsternwick, and Mr. E. R. Morton, Drouin).

The private funeral took place to the Rushworth cemetery on Thursday, last week, where Mr Matthews (Church of England) officiated at the graveside and Mr. Graham Diggle carried out the funeral arrangements.
