The death occurred about midnight on Wednesday last of Mrs. Maria Geyle, widow of the late Mr. William Henry Geyle, of Rushworth, who died on 10th January last.

The late Mrs. Geyle, who was aged 76 years, came to Rushworth as a schoolteacher, her maiden name being Smith, and about 45 years ago she and Mr. Geyle were married in Bendigo, Mrs. Geyle's home town. She had lived at Rushworth ever since.

For some considerable time Mrs. Geyle had been in indifferent health, and the unexpected death of her husband probably hastened her end.

She was held in very high esteem by a wide circle of friends, and the deepest sympathy is extended to Mr. W. C. Geyle in the loss of his mother following so quickly upon the death of his father.

Mr. W. C. Geyle was the only surviving child, a daughter Leila (Mrs Mosley, of Orbost), having died some eight years ago.

The remains were interred privately in Rushworth cemetery on Thursday afternoon.
