

Mrs Peel, wife of Thomas

Mr Thos. Peel's many friends will extremely regret the sad bereavement he has sustained in the death of his wife, which sad event took place on Monday evening last.

Deceased had been in poor health for some considerable time, but it was only about one week prior to her death that she was compelled to take to her bed.

With her husband, she arrived on Rushworth some eighteen years ago, and has resided here ever since, and was generally respected, being of a very quiet, unassuming nature.

Deceased was quite a young woman only 39 years of age. Mr Peel is left to mourn his loss with six children, the youngest of whom is but five years of age, and much sympathy is felt for him in his trouble.

The remains were interred in the Rushworth cemetery on Wednesday, there being a large following of mourners. The Rev. J. Walker conducted the service at the grave.
