

## **Mrs Alice Bailey**

**Rushworth Chronicle**

Death has claimed another of the pioneers of Rushworth, in the person of Mrs. Alice Margaret Bailey, who passed away early on Friday morning last, at her residence, Stanhope road, after an illness extending over the past two months.

The late Mrs. Bailey was 73 years of age and was born in Bedford, England. She came out to Australia with her parents when a child of 13 years of age and is therefore a colonist of 60 years.

She lived at Rochester for a time and was married in Bendigo, when she was 21 years of age. She and her husband came to Rushworth over 30 years ago, and resided here up till the time of her death.

She was much respected and her death is regretted by her many friends. She leaves her husband and four children (one having died in infancy) --- John Nicholl (Shepparton), Harry (Shepparton), Frederick (Melbourne), Mary (Mrs. P. Patrick, Wangaratta).

The funeral took place on Saturday last, the remains being interred in the Rushworth Cemetery.

The Rev. Canon Grist officiated at the graveside and Mr. E. F. Anderson carried out the funeral arrangements.
