

## Mrs H. Pepperell

Our readers will learn with regret of the death of Mrs Pepperell, wife of Mr H. Pepperell, saddler, of Rushworth, which occurred at Bendigo yesterday morning, although it will at the same time be recognised that death was a happy release to deceased from her terrible sufferings, she having suffered for a considerable time from cancer.

Deceased had been confined to her bed for the past twelve months, nevertheless she bore her sufferings with great fortitude and was of a jovial disposition to the last.

Prior to her marriage with Mr Pepperell deceased was a Miss Glass, and for some years occupied a position in the Rushworth State school, where she was held in very high esteem by teachers and scholars alike.

Deceased was only a young woman and every sympathy is expressed for the bereaved husband.

***This report is obviously silent on the place of burial. The Rushworth cemetery records have H. Pepperell in grave 216, and a Christiana Pepperell in the same grave. It seems probable that Christiana is the Mrs Pepperell referred to here.***
